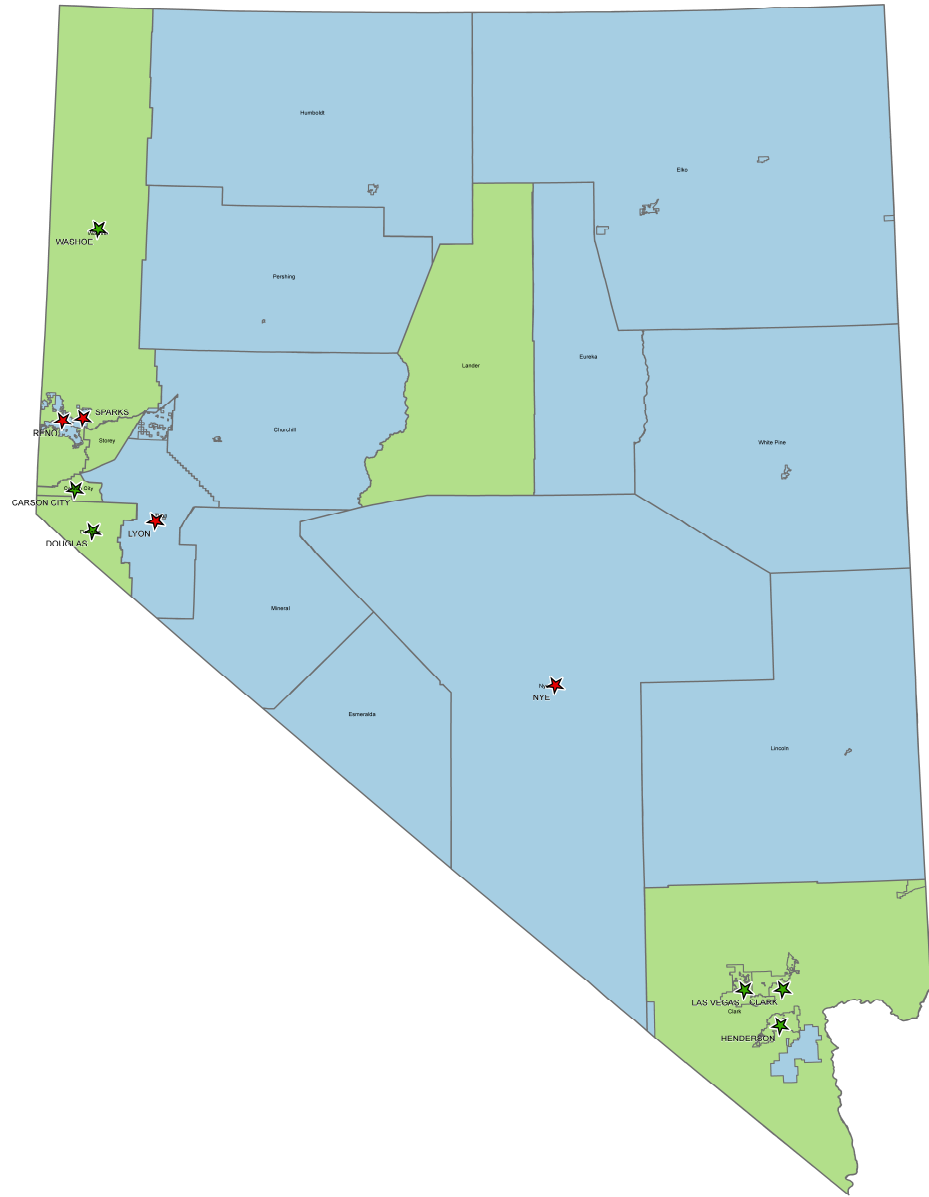

#### NOTES:

As of May 2017, 34 communities in Nevada participate in the National Flood Insurance Program. Of these communities, 10 (or 29%) participate in the Community Rating System (CRS).

Of the top 10 Nevada communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 6 participate in the CRS. The remaining 4 communities present an outreach opportunity for encouraging participation in the CRS.

#### Benefits of Joining the CRS

- \* Activities credited by the CRS provide direct benefits to the community, including enhanced public safety, reduction in flood damage and environmental protection.
- \* Residents are reminded that the community is working to protect them from flood losses.
