

As of May 2017, 292 communities in Washington participate in the National Flood Insurance Program. Of these communities, 35 (or 12%) participate in the Community Rating System (CRS).

Of the top 50 Washington communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 28 participate in the CRS. The remaining 22 communities present an outreach opportunity for encouraging participation in the CRS.





Benefits of Joining the CRS

- * Activities credited by the CRS provide direct benefits to the community, including enhanced public safety, reduction in flood damage and environmental protection.
- * Residents are reminded that the community is working to protect them from flood losses.
- *Public information activities will build a knowledgeable consitituency interested in supporting and improving flood protection measures.
