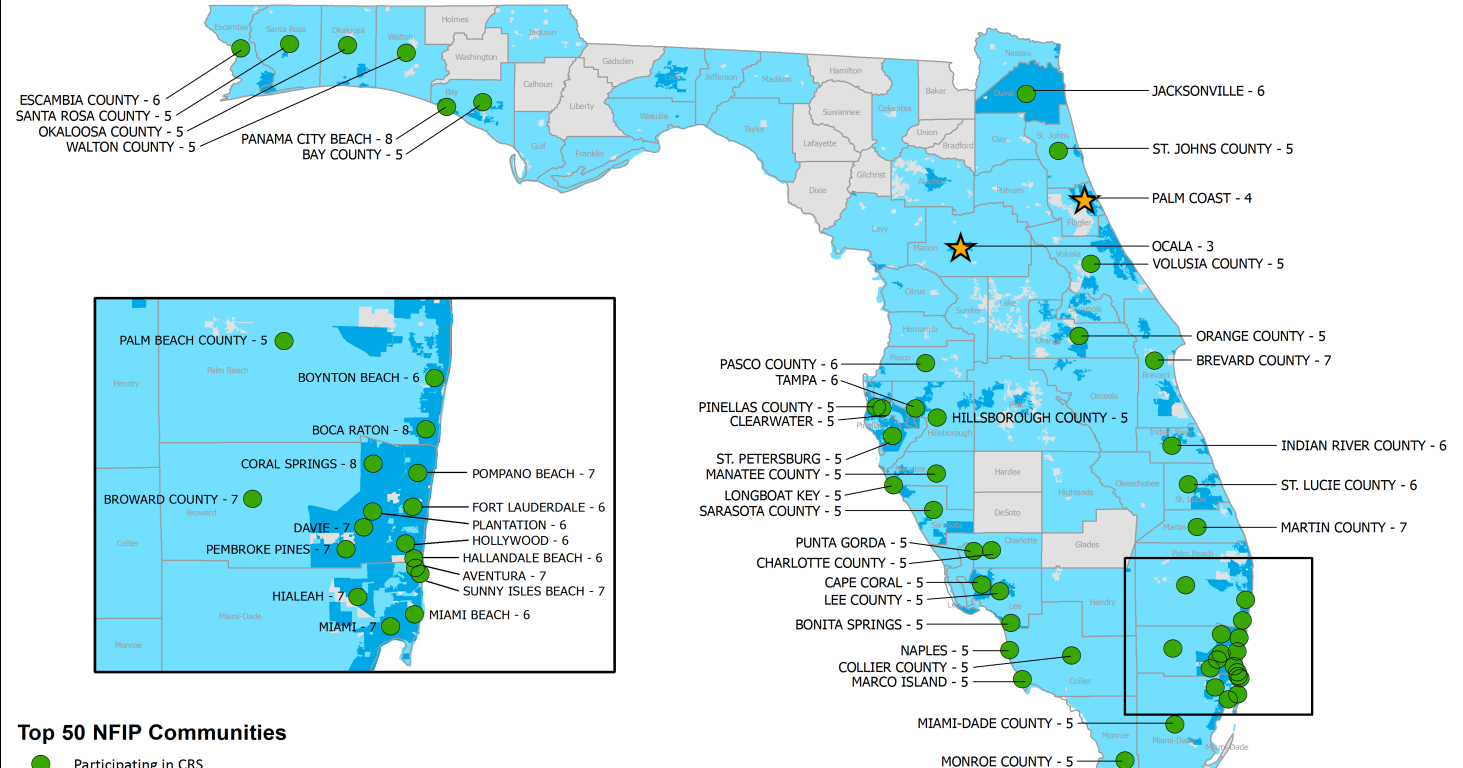

 Of the top 50 Florida communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 100% participate in CRS.
