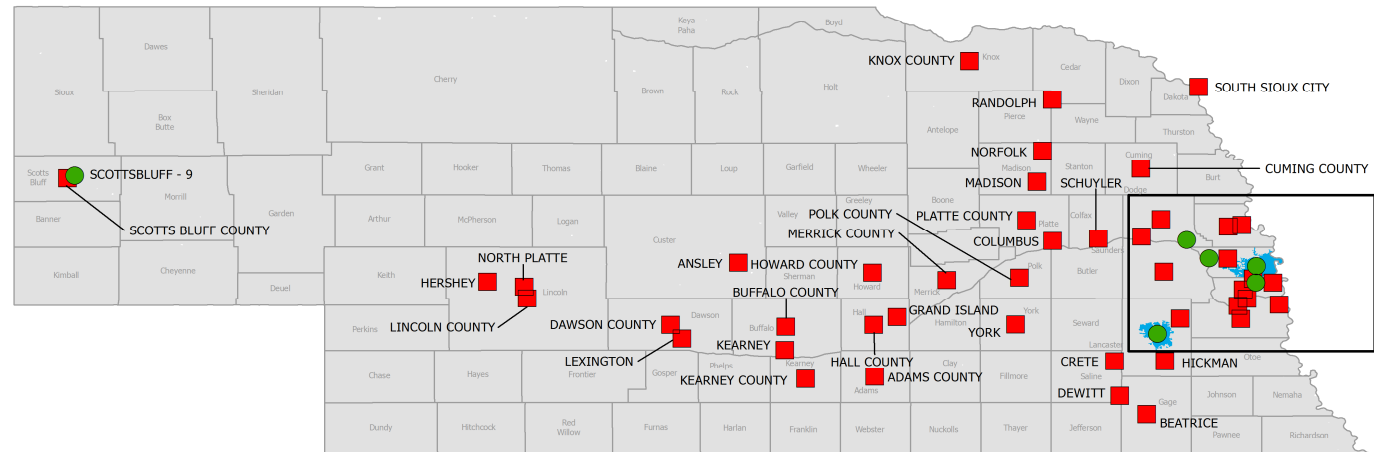
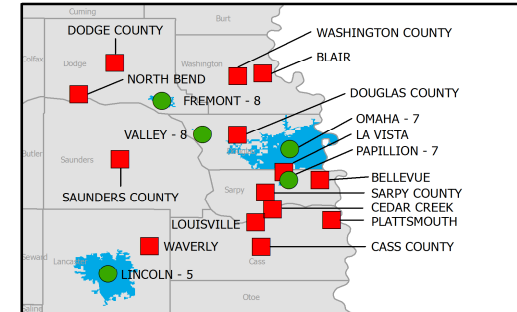

NOTES:

As of October 2018, 409 communities in Nebraska participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Of these communities, 6 (or 1%) participate in the Community Rating System (CRS). Of the top 50 Nebraska communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 6 participate in the CRS. The remaining 44 communities present an outreach opportunity for encouraging participation in the CRS.

Benefits of Joining the CRS

- * Activities credited by the CRS provide direct benefits to the community, including enhanced public safety, reduction in flood damage and environmental protection.
- * Residents are reminded that the community is working to protect them from flood losses.
- * Public information activities will build a knowledgeable constituency interested in supporting and improving flood protection measures.
- * Money stays in the community instead of being spent on insurance premiums.
