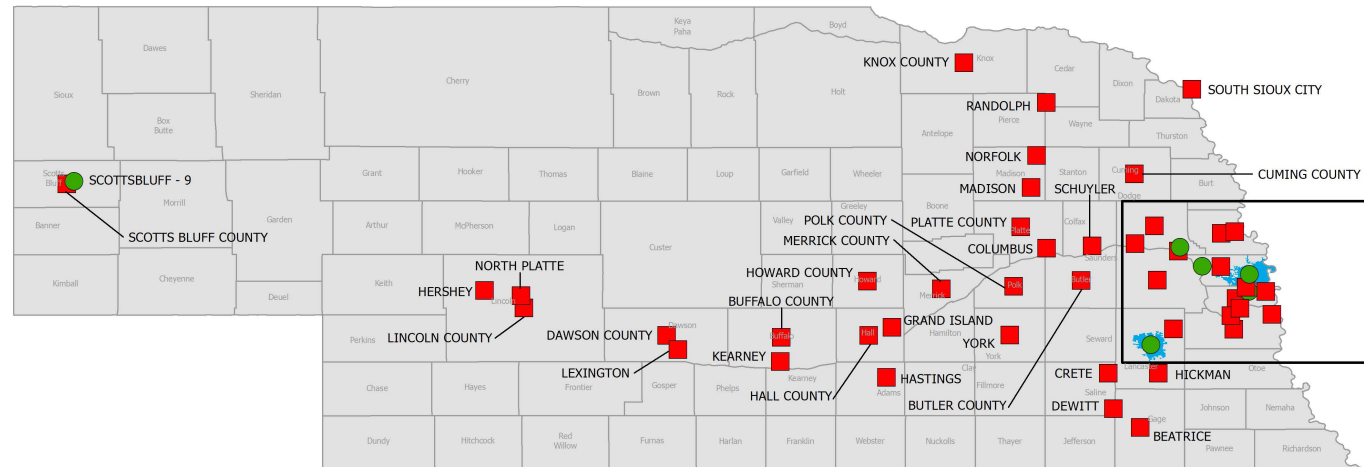
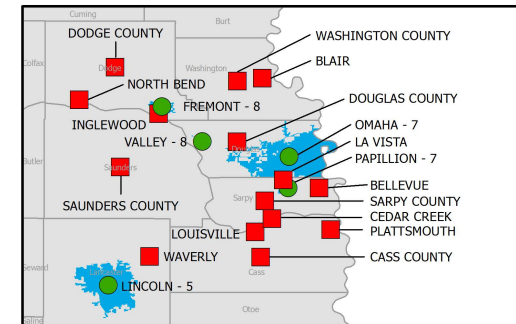

 As of August 2019, 409 communities in Nebraska participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Of these communities, 6 (or 1%) participate in the Community Rating System (CRS).
 Of the top 50 Nebraska communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 6 participate in the CRS. The remaining 44 communities present an outreach opportunity for encouraging participation in the CRS.
