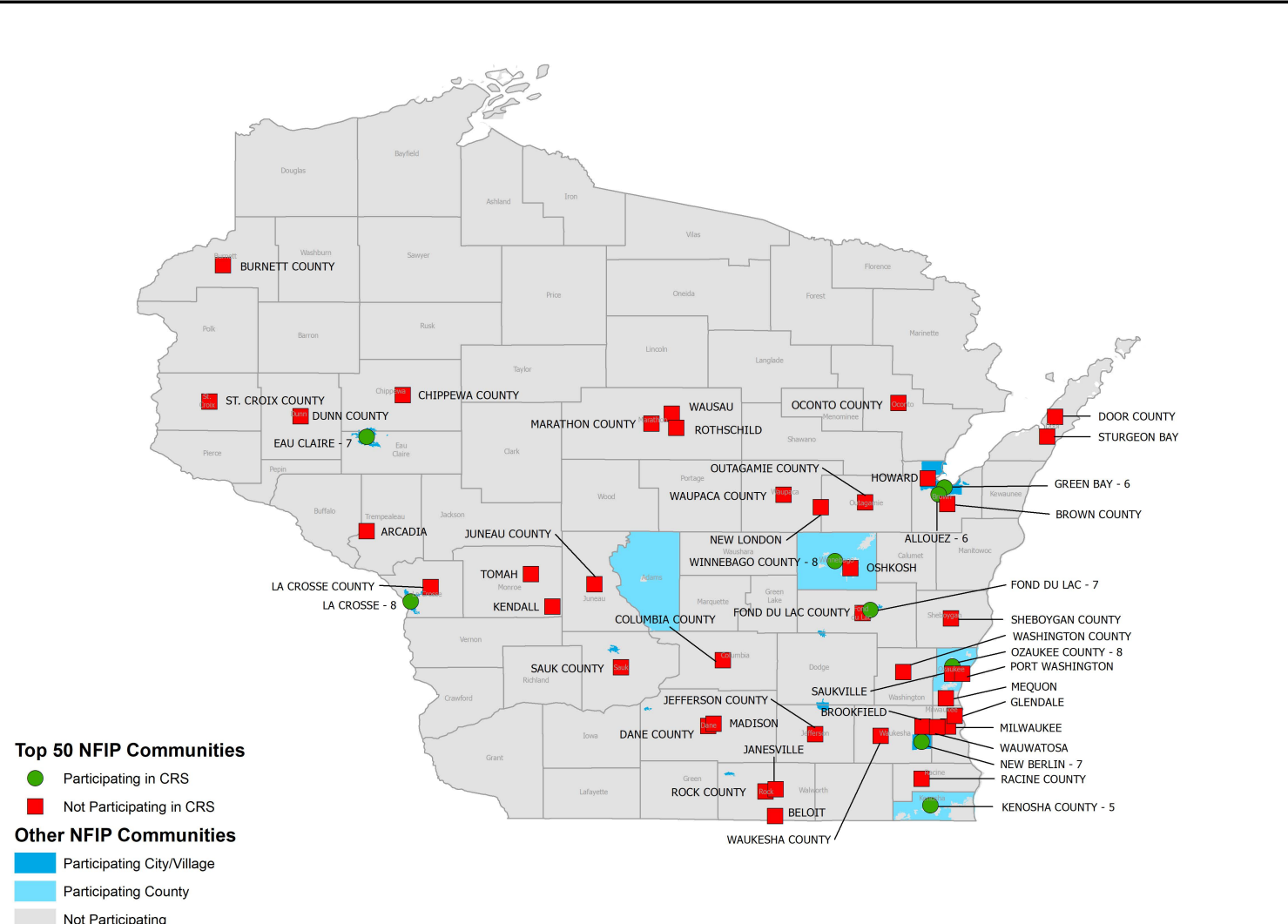

 As of August 2019, 554 communities in Wisconsin participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).  
 Of these communities, 17 (or 3%) participate in the Community Rating System (CRS).  
 Of the top 50 Wisconsin communities (in terms of flood insurance policies-in-force), 9 participate in the CRS.  
 The remaining 41 communities present an outreach opportunity for encouraging participation in the CRS.
